

These are national insurance credit top-ups which can be added to fill gaps in contributions records. They can be backdated to 2011.

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New episode of Our Turn to Talk out now!

In the latest episode of National Children's Bureau Youth-led podcast programme, Our Turn to Talk, Lauren, Louise, Grace, Lotte and Eden discuss their experiences of friendship as autistic young people.

In this episode the young people explore a variety of topics, including:

- Communicating with people who are not autistic
 - The impact of over- or under-sensitivity to sensory stimuli on a daily basis
- The effects of autism masking relationships
- How neurotypical people can make autistic people feel comfortable in their friendship.
