

Dear Parent/Guardian,

Research has found that reading levels can slide backwards by about a month's progress during the summer break, known as the 'Summer Slide'. To prevent this and encourage a lifelong love of reading, we are running a sponsored read over the summer holidays.

The project is being organised in conjunction with our Independent Usborne Partner, Sara's Story Store, and all the money raised will go towards brand new books for our school. In addition to the sponsorship money, Usborne will also donate up to 60% of the total raised in **EXTRA FREE BOOKS** to the school. So, for every £10 raised, we could get an extra £6 in FREE Usborne books!

Please encourage your child to spend a small amount of time reading each day. They can read books, comics, magazines, newspapers, menus, websites, recipes, poems, leaflets, instructions — anything with words! All pupils will be given reading logs so they can record how many minutes per day they spend reading.

The class who collectively reads for the most minutes throughout the challenge will be awarded a class trophy and crowned the Class Champions of this exciting event!

We also kindly ask you to support our sponsored read by sponsoring your child and encouraging them to actively fundraise for our school by seeking sponsorship from their family, friends and community. Prizes will be awarded to children who show exceptional fundraising efforts:

- Bronze: £50+ raised through sponsorship

- Silver: £75+ raised through sponsorship

- Gold: £100+ raised through sponsorship

The pupil who raises the most money through sponsorship will be awarded the **GRAND PRIZE** of a hamper of brand new books to take home!
